*God Bless America! June 30-July 3*



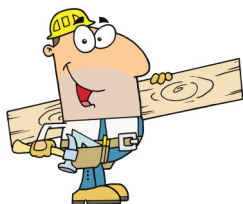

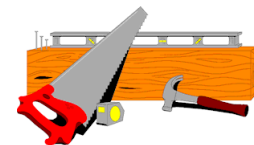
*Airplanes, Rockets and Flying Machines July 07-11*

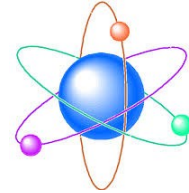
*Woodworking July 14-18*
